Performance Initiatives Undertaken

The Unit hosted four station tours during the reporting period. During the tour, guests are invited to observe hosts in the studio and hear about what it is like to work in the radio broadcasting industry. The Unit hosted 20 students and 2 adults from Crossroads Middle School (October 3, 2024); 12 individuals from a group called "To The Rescue" which provides personalized support for individuals with disabilities, and home health care for older adults (October 15, 2024); 6 individuals from Integrated Life Choices which provides support for adults with intellectual disabilities (November 21, 2024); and 15 students from the Colorado Media School (November 26, 2024) .

During the reporting period, several of the Unit's employees participated in speaking engagements to educate students about careers in broadcasting and sports broadcasting. An on-air host spoke to 5th grade students at Discovery Magnet School's Career Day (February 7, 2024). One of the sports talk hosts was keynote speaker at the Career Day at Eaton Middle School (March 25, 2024). A sales manager spoke to 200 middle school students at Mountain Ridge Middle School (May 9, 2024). A program director spoke at an event at The University of Denver called Girls in the Game to encourage and inspire girls to consider a career in sport6s and sports broadcasting (August 17, 2024). A digital sports analyst spoke at Colorado University's CMCI Sports Media Summit (February 23, 2024) as well as numerous other guest speaking opportunities around the campus. The digital sports analyst also teaches a sports media/sports broadcasting class in the communications school at the Colorado University- Boulder as well as a sports writing class each semester. An on-air host and a board operator teach broadcasting classes at the Colorado Media School. An on-air host participated in the program Young AmeriTowne where a group of 4th grade students from American Academy learned about how to run a radio station from a business standpoint and a creative one.

Employees of the Unit participated in the company led mentorship program. This program began in February 2024 and ran for six months. The program allows employees to be paired with mentors across the organization to gain career development and insight into other departments and roles within the organization.

Bonneville International was a sponsor of the 2023-2024 National Association of Broadcasters Leadership Foundation (NABLF) Media Sales Academy student mentoring and recruiting program. To begin the program on October 27, 2023, the Executive Vice President of Business Affairs and Strategy spoke to a group of about 20 college students about the radio industry. On October 28, 2023, the Senior Vice President of Human Resources and Director of Sales (Seattle) presented company information and information about possible career paths in broadcasting sales to the program participants. One participant in the program was then mentored by an Account Executive (Sacramento) for about three months. After the conclusion of the program in March 2024, contact information for all program participants was provided to Market Managers and sales leaders to support recruiting efforts.

During the reporting period, The Unit provided training opportunities for its management team and its employees. The Unit's managers participated in Manager Meet-Ups covering such topics as Merit Training (2/7/24 and 2/8/24). Employees were invited to participate in on-going sessions titled "Own Your Own Development". Topics covered included Navigating Bonneville International Corporation Learning and Development Resources (1/25/24), Al at Bonneville (2/22/24), and Giving and Receiving Feedback (3/14/24). In addition, employees of the Unit are given Franklin Covey All Access Passes to aid in personal development. New Hires also participated in sexual harassment and discrimination training as well as Franklin Covey's Unconscious Bias program.
